Our French hosts have now outlined the weekend activities of 14/15 June, which will be attended by the British Ambassador as well as French military and civil dignitaries. We are now able to advise attendees of costs:

Ferry - £213.79 (includes DB&B) Casino de Dieppe Hotel - €461.25pp (includes meal on arrival and all breakfasts) - approx. £387.61pp.

The 26 pax who have already expressed interest will receive letters from the Secretary shortly with booking details. Confirmation of attendance and a deposit of £213.79 is required by **21 Feb**. There are still vacancies for people to join the trip.
